2	Departmental buildings (approximate area – 2100 sq. m.)	2.40 crores	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Four departmental buildings required.• Initial drawings are ready.
3	Canteen including kitchen & wash area (Seating capacity of about 200 students and 40 faculty members - 450 sq. m.)	56 lakhs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Innovations happen more at the canteen than in the class room or laboratories so SGGs desperately needs a good canteen.
4	Alumni office with guest house (3 rooms and an office complete with toilet blocks and interiors – 90 sq. m.)	15 lakhs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Alumni Association activities are taking shape and need some infrastructure to support it.
5	Lake project	1.50 crores	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We are lucky to have a stream running in our campus which we can develop in to a wonderful lake and sort of chowpati.
6	Incubation Centre (1500 sq. m.)	1.50 crores	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Built up area to house 10 to 12 incubation units for enhanced collaborative R&D activities on campus.

2	Sponsorship for needy students	--	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hostel charges, mess charges, etc can be estimated on a per year basis and accordingly funds required can be computed. It is for the alumni to decide how much money he / she wishes to contribute or how many students he / she is willing to take care of.
3	Endowment Chair	1 crore approx. per chair	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An alumni or an organization may decide to provide a Professor to a particular department by way of providing a chair. Salary component is considered here. A professor (retired or otherwise) with outstanding track record can be appointed for teaching as well as research & development.
4	Adjunct Professor sponsorship	30 lakhs approx. per Professor	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Renowned Industry personnel / academicians can be enrolled as adjunct faculty even while they are working with some other organization. Honorarium component, TA & Hospitality expenses are considered here.

Note:

- The choice of taking up a particular activity is (obviously) totally yours.
- Instead of giving money, if alumni are willing to complete the project and hand over to the institute then also it is welcome rather it is more welcome.
- If someone is willing to contribute for development of laboratories, the exact equipment / software requirements, money required etc can be planned on a case to case basis. Civil works of about 135 to 150 sq. m. should cost us 18 lakhs each.
